Shooing away candles from the wax of honey bees

While beekeeping has been a profitable cottage industry in rural areas, this innovative venture called Siachen Candles & Waxes has rendered a whole new direction to bee culture, namely that of extracting wax from bee hives and applying them in candle making.

Modern day beeswax candles are expensive to purchase, and so, Neel Singh of Himachal Pradesh, decided to take an unconventional way to making the process simple and safe.

Neel stumbled on the idea by accident, when he happened to visit his friend who had been a bee keeper for many years and observed that large quantities of wax was getting wasted, unnoticed. The idea dawned upon him when his friend burnt the remains and resulted in a gooey, waxy substrate.



Neel used three portions of hot bees wax with one portion of coconut oil and one portion of herbal palm and a 50 ply wick that are available at economical rates in the neighborhood arts and crafts stores. Using a glass tunnel hard jar made the wax solidify stronger and hold out longer. Diluting bees wax is a painstaking process and initially the local investor who had agreed to fund Neel's project backed away in doubt. However, Neel did not give
